A Grosse Pointe Shores Harbor Committee meeting was held on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 in the Council Chambers of the Grosse Pointe Shores Municipal Building, 795 Lake Shore Rd.

**Approval of Minutes**

**Harbor Master Report**

Krolczyk reported that we have currently taken in \$145,000 in well rentals and stated that he will be meeting with a potential contractor regarding replacement of dock decking. Committee members went through the harbor rules and noted any changes.

**Old Business**

Committee members went through the harbor rules and noted any changes. Motion to approve Harbor rules by Kratz and seconded by D'Hondt, approved with changes.

**New Business**

Krolczyk encouraged the Harbor committee members to visit the park and note the new retention wall to slow down the lake water infiltration into the park along with steps installed at the kayak launch and battleship row wells. He also stated currently the only wells affected are #7 & #8.

**Committee Member Comments**

Ritter asked that Krolczyk check into weed removal stating that GPYC seems to be slacking in the northeast corner of our harbor. Kratz inquired about the liquid goose deterrent and if it would work on hard surfaces such as the docks. Schroder would like to see fishing line installed between fender boards at the end of the T-docks to deter birds from landing. Ramsdell inquired

if the well renter in #117 could possibly retain his well for 2020 in which Krolczyk and the committee feels he should be placed in a larger well.
