NEW BUSINESS

Bill Gough from Azimuth Capital Management went through their handout on the portfolio summary for the calendar year end. He explained while going through the handout that they feel the fundamentals for growth in the market are still present and that they expect a 20% earning to growth for 2018 along with some pull back from time to time. That is based upon some fears of inflation.

He pointed out that as rates move up on some fixed issues bonds will be replaced higher income ones. He mentioned that they expect the Fed to raise rates 3 or 4 times in 2018. He also mentioned that based upon the current allocation as approved by the pension Board they trimmed back stocks 3x in 2017 to bring our portfolio into compliance with the board allocation policy.

Bill also passed out handouts from both the Commonfund and from Barings Core Property Fund and went through them with the Board.

Under Item B Fiduciary Liability Insurance, a MOTION was made by Commissioner Rohr and seconded by Alternate Commissioner Way to approve the 3 year proposal from the Cincinnati Insurance Companies. PASSED 5-0.
