PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!!**

1. As in the past, the park pass applications are used to update our census and emergency records, as well as for their obvious recreational purpose. Therefore, your cooperation in completing this form whether or not you require park passes is appreciated.
2. On the above portion, list all members of the family **permanently** residing at your address in Grosse Pointe Shores, names, ages, your address and phone number(s). Please print neatly and complete the entire form. You may drop off the completed application at the Shores' Administrative Office on the 2nd floor of the municipal building, place it in the white drop box in front of the building, or return it by mail - *Proof of residence may be requested for first time applicants.* **Park passes will be available for pickup (by an adult) at the Park Gate House (800 Lake Shore Road) beginning May 1, 2014.**
3. We reserve the right to request verification of each resident in the household and will accept the following proofs of identification: Adult — Driver's License (photo ID), Voter Registration. Children — Birth Certificate, School ID.
4. Use of park passes by anyone other than the person to whom the pass was issued will result in confiscation of the pass.
5. Replacement park passes cost \$5 and do not include guest privileges.
6. Do not throw away your park passes at the end of the summer season. Weather permitting they can be used to gain access to Vernier Hill and the skating rinks during the winter season.
7. Park passes issued to those under the age of 15 may be exchanged for wrist tags at the pool office upon the official opening of the park, Friday, May 23rd.
8. Family/group picnics of 15 or more may be scheduled for weekends or holidays at least seven (7) days prior to event. All group events are scheduled on a first-come first-serve basis.
9. Park rules are listed on the back of your park pass - to ensure safe recreational activities, your cooperation in reading and adhering to the park and harbor rules is requested.
